Membership

The charity was established in 1942 to help in cases of hardship among the women who served in the Women's Royal Naval Service (WRNS). A member is automatically anyone who served in the WRNS including those who transferred to the Royal Navy on 1 November 1993, or anyone who has served in the WRNS since 3 September 1939.

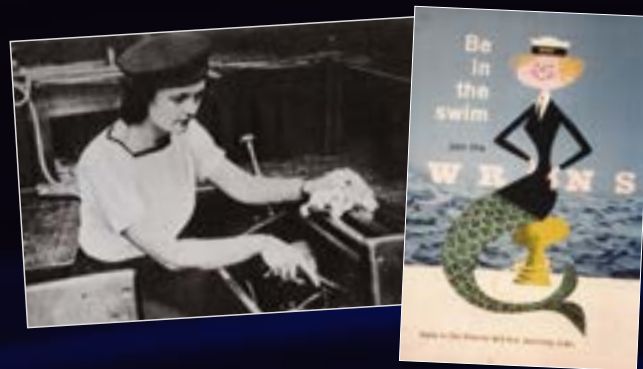
How the Trust can help

The Trust exists to provide relief in cases of necessity or distress among its members (both officers and ratings) and their dependants; to make provision in suitable cases for assistance with further education; to make contributions to other suitable charities to enable them to carry out their respective objectives for the benefit of the Trust's members; and to do anything ancillary to any of the above.

Regular Charitable Payments

- **General Amenity Grants** - These grants help with day-to-day living expenses, e.g. the payment of bills, clothing or perhaps household goods otherwise unaffordable.
- **Care Enhancement Grant** - Weekly assistance for beneficiaries of state pensionable age. Small grants are given towards the cost of permanent or temporary care in either a care home or their own home.
- **Overseas Grant** - A set weekly allowance for beneficiaries of state pensionable age who live overseas.
- **Weekly Maintenance Grant** - A set weekly allowance for beneficiaries of state pensionable age, living in the UK.
- **Weekly Support Supplement** - A set weekly allowance awarded to beneficiaries below state pensionable age, who are too young to qualify for Pension Credit, and yet too old to find employment easily, or too infirm to do so.

All Regular Charitable Payments are reviewed on an annual basis, which means we are kept informed of the individual's welfare and can reassess needs as required.



One off Grants

The types of demand can be extremely varied. The main areas of current expenditure are categorised as below, but there is no set parameter and each and every request is taken on its own merit.

- Debts (Priority) and Arrears
- Education
- Funeral Expenses
- Household Goods and Repairs
- Medical Aids
- Removal and Travel Expenses
- Rent and Deposits

Grants Process

The Trust has no caseworkers of its own and therefore works mainly with SSAFA and the Royal British Legion. Their caseworkers contact applicants on behalf of the Trust and then submit a case for the Grants Committee to consider. Members of the Committee are all former members of the WRNS (including those currently serving in the Royal Navy), and give their time and assistance voluntarily.
